



MOVEMENT DISORDERS
A Practical Course for Paediatric Neurologists
Wolfson College, Cambridge
17-18 November 2011

GENERAL INFORMATION

The British Paediatric Neurology Association is very pleased to announce its series of Advanced Paediatric Neurology (APN) courses. The first in this series will be a practical Movement Disorders course aimed at consultant and trainee paediatric neurologists, and specialists involved in either the diagnosis or management of these interesting disorders.

The course is being developed by an expert steering group: Martin Smith, Birmingham; Manju Kurian, London; Lucinda Carr, London; Jean-Pierre Lin, London; Alasdair Parker, Cambridge (chair); Arni Majumdar, Bristol and Colin Ferrie, Leeds.

There will be particular emphasis on:

- How to assess these children in practical terms that can guide the clinician in a busy clinic
- Diagnostic issues from simple home videos through to biochemical and genetic analysis
- Classification of common movement disorders and identification of rarer ones
- Practical difficulties with their management in terms of state of the art drug and therapeutic input, acute issues, as well as more practical issues around multi disciplinary and allied health professional support

The course has been developed along the same lines as the very successful Paediatric Epilepsy Training programme (www.bpna.org.uk/pet) and the course format will be immediately familiar to anybody who has attended the PET courses. It will be a mixture of both workshops and lectures, with interactive sessions allowing attendees to bring their own clinical experience to the group's attention. Attendees will need to participate in the interactive and debate format of the course.

This course will complement the BPNA distance learning course unit 'Central motor deficits; congenital and acquired spinal cord disorders' which will be available to study online shortly. For further details of this please go to: www.bpna.org.uk/DL.

COURSE VENUE

The course is being held at Wolfson College, Cambridge, CB3 9BB. There is free car parking at Wolfson College. The closest train station is Cambridge (approx 10 minutes by taxi).

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ACCOMMODATION

Both are about 10 minutes by taxi from Wolfson, however we will book taxis back and forth in the morning and evening. Murray Edwards College is a pleasant 25 minute walk. Bedrooms are basic but all have en suite facilities.

Course registration will be from 8.45am with a prompt start at 9.15am on Thursday 17 November. Accommodation is available at Madingley Hall on the night of 16th if you require it.
