Visit the **BALTIC** for the latest contemporary art, explore classic artworks at **Laing Art Gallery**, travel back in time at **Discovery Museum** and see science evolve at **Life Science Centre**. Journey through the ages at **Great North Museum** or take an exclusive look behind-the-scenes with a **St James' Park Stadium Tour**.

Listen to a world of music at **The Sage Gateshead**, sing along to pop and rock at **Metro Radio Arena**, enjoy a classic concert at **City Hall** or **Journal Tyne Theatre** or hear the biggest international DJs at **Digital** nightclub.

See the Georgian architecture of **Grey Street** and **Grainger Town**, seek out public artworks around NewcastleGateshead **Quayside**, learn about the hidden past of **Blackfriars** or take in breathtaking panoramic city views from the historic **Castle Keep**.

Watch great drama unfold at **Theatre Royal** or be the first to experience cutting edge drama at **Live Theatre** and **Northern Stage**, explore contemporary dance forms at **Dance City** or simply people-watch on NewcastleGateshead's **Quayside**.

Shop for anything and everything in **Eldon Square**, browse designer creations and retro finds around **Hood Street**, **High Bridge** and **Market Street** or take a short trip to **Metrocentre**, Europe's largest shopping centre.

Meet amidst the buzz of **Monument**, join friends for a stroll through **Leazes Park**, come together for events on **Baltic Square** or share the views from **Gateshead Millennium Bridge**.

Eat at the many restaurants on the **Quayside**, grab lunch at a café around **Grey Street** as you watch the world go by, sample international cuisine in **Chinatown** or enjoy the best views in town before sitting down to eat at **SIX** at **BALTIC**.

Stay in one of the area's many hotels – there's something to suit all ages and budgets from an alternative hostel experience at **Euro Hostel** to luxury suites at the **Hilton**. Call in at a Visitor Information Centre where the friendly staff will be happy to find you a room.

Enjoy spectacular views of the Tyne's **seven bridges**, take in the excitement of premiership football at Newcastle United's **St James' Park** or enjoy the busy nightlife at **The Gate**, the **Bigg Market** or Newcastle's fashionable **Collingwood Street**, AKA **The Diamond Strip**.

Wander in the **Ouseburn Valley** to find great pub food and live music at **The Cluny**, local ales at **The Cumberland Arms**, tall tales at **Seven Stories** and artwork for sale at **The Biscuit Factory**.

Explore

NewcastleGateshead is a fascinating place to explore on foot and also has an excellent public transport system to help you get around.

QuayLink buses connect all the major attractions and destinations in central NewcastleGateshead. The Metro connects you to the airport, the coast and surrounding areas – both services are fast, frequent and efficient. Use the maps below to plan your journey or visit a Nexus TravelShop for further travel information.

Day Rover tickets allow unlimited travel on most public transport within the Tyne and Wear region.

Bus

Buses connect to major destinations outside the central area and the wider region.

For the Angel of the North the 21 and 22 Angel Bus (Go North East) runs from Pilgrim Street^{D4} via Gateshead Interchange^{F8} every 8 minutes; the journey takes approximately 25 minutes. For Metrocentre the 100 (Stagecoach) runs from Pilgrim Street^{D4} about every 10 minutes; the journey takes 15 minutes. For Saltwell Park the 53 and 54 (Go North East) run from Market Street^{D4} via Gateshead Interchange^{F8} every 10 minutes; the journey takes 15–20 minutes.

For other destinations, buses to the North generally leave from Haymarket Bus Station^{D3}, and to the West and South from Eldon Square Bus Station^{C3}.

Taxi

Black Cab Taxis (Hackney Carriages) can be picked up from major transport interchanges and designated Taxi Ranks.

Taxi journeys between central NewcastleGateshead and Newcastle International Airport take 20–30 minutes.

Train

Newcastle Central Station^{C6} is a major hub for both national and regional services. The local rail network connects Central Station to destinations throughout the North East.

Cycleways & footpaths

Hadrian's Way and Keelman's Way are long distance cycleways and footpaths that form part of the National Cycle Network and follow the north and south banks of the River Tyne.

Tours

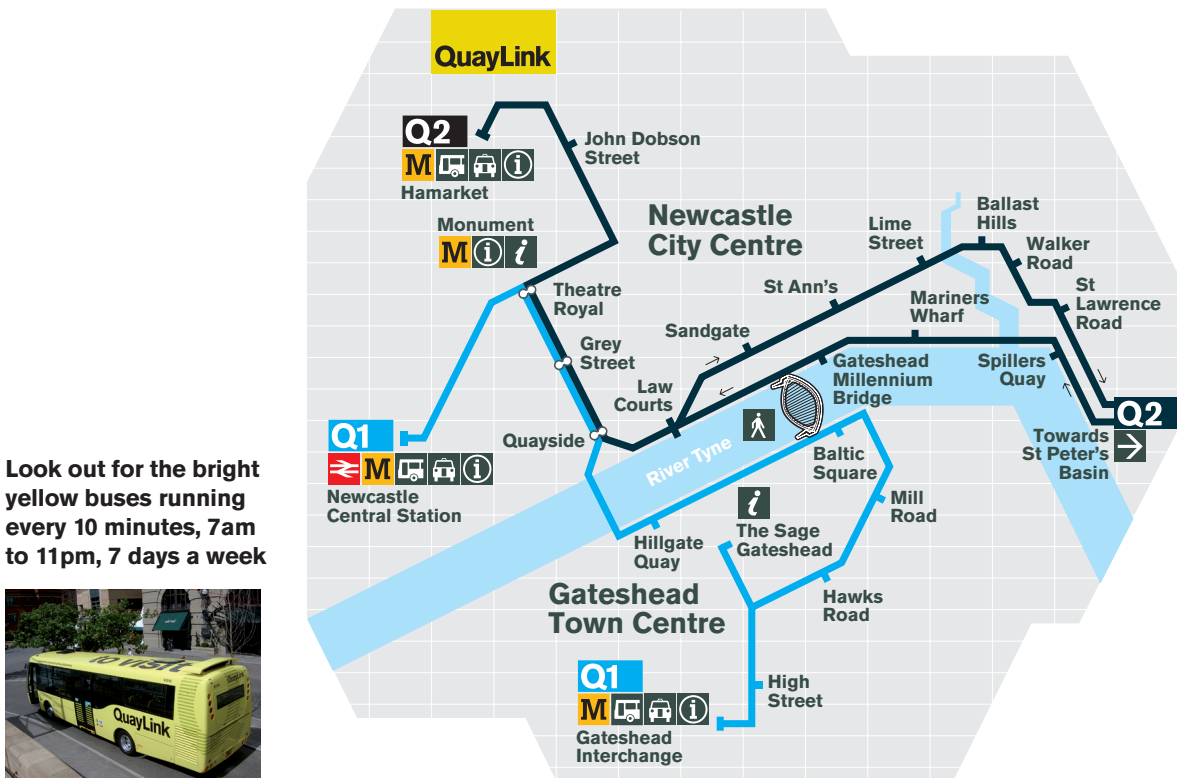
Walking tours with professional guides operate most of the year. Contact Newcastle Tourist Information Centre for details. The City Sightseeing open top bus tours start and finish at Newcastle Central Station^{C6}. Buses run from March to December. There are two River Tyne cruises: River Escapes starting from the Quayside^{G6}; and Shields Ferry starting from South Shields ferry landing.

Q1 Q2 QuayLink buses

The bright yellow QuayLink buses offer a high frequency, accessible and easy-to-use service. Routes connect the attractions and sights of the Quayside^{G6} and Gateshead Quays^{G6} with Newcastle Central Station^{C6}, Haymarket Bus Station^{D3}, Ouseburn^{J4} and Lime Street^{H4}, and Gateshead Interchange^{F8}.

Tickets can be bought on board. All Network Traveltickets are valid.

Q QuayLink bus stops are indicated by yellow icons on the Walk map on reverse.



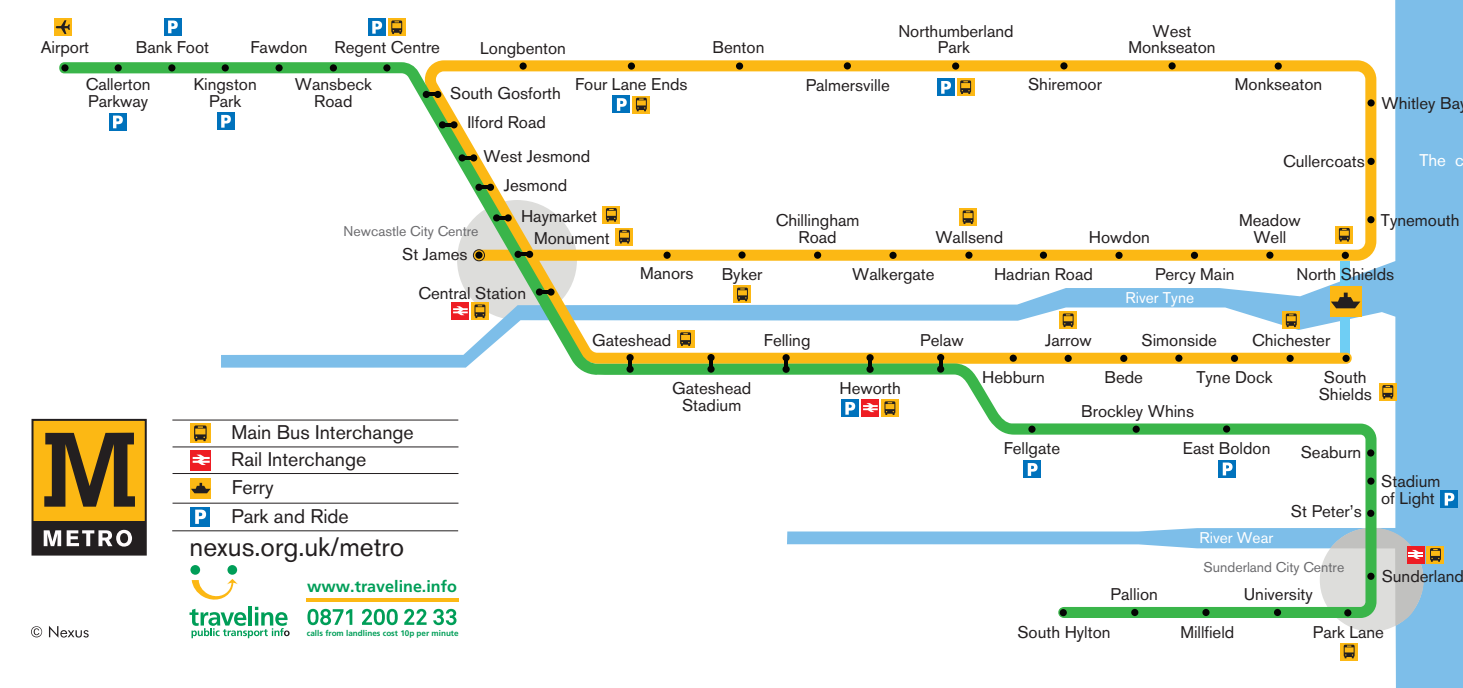

M Metro

Tyne and Wear Metro is a light rail system connecting all major destinations in the region. Services link central NewcastleGateshead with the airport in 20 minutes, and the coast and Sunderland in 30 minutes. The ride between Newcastle Central Station^{C6} and Gateshead Interchange^{F8} takes less than 5 minutes. The Metro is also the ideal way to get to main shopping areas around Haymarket^{D3} and Monument^{D4} and the hotels, cafés and restaurants of Jesmond.

Metro trains run from around 5.30am to midnight, every 5–10 minutes during the day and 10–20 minutes in the evenings. Tickets can be bought from machines at all Metro stations. If you're planning to make a few journeys, buy a Metro DaySaver offering a day's unlimited travel.

Park and Ride allows easy access via the Metro to central areas. Park and Ride car parks are indicated on the Metro map.
