## Video Consent Form

Education is an important way to improve care for children and families with neurological problems. The British Paediatric Neurology Association (BPNA) uses videos of children and young people as part of their teaching resources. Videos are an excellent way to show what conditions look like and how we can best provide care. The BPNA requires consent to keep copies of videos. Choosing to give or not give consent will not affect your child's health care.

Videos are kept securely as digital files on computers and cloud-based web services. The teaching resources are used both inside and outside hospitals and clinics, for example in schools. They may also be used in other countries as part of international neurology training. They are distributed to defined health care professionals. Your child's name or other personal details will not be shared with other organisations and will be held in accordance with the Data Protection Act. Your child may be recognisable depending on how your child appears in the video. The video may be used with fictitious details within scenario-based teaching. Because we share videos we cannot fully guarantee that the video will not enter the public domain. The videos may be used indefinitely but you or your child may withdraw consent at any time by contacting the BPNA.
